JS WORLD FREIGHT COMPLETE LAND TRANSPORT OF OIL & GAS EQUIPMENT

JS World Freight Distributor have completed a land transport project from Singapore to Pasir Gudang in Malaysia.

The cargo consisted of oil & gas equipment which was originally imported to Singapore last year



for a gas pipeline leaking project in Indonesia and after completion, it was brought back to Singapore for storage. Then, in August, the client of JS World Freight Distributor from the Netherlands (DCN) needed to use the equipment once again to connect with an oil & gas vessel located in Pasir Gudang in Malaysia which is destined for another project in the Middle East.

JS World Freight Distributor engaged a total of 15 low-loaders to transport all the equipment, weighing a total of almost 300tns, within 2 days, travelling at night with a police escort. JS's excellent lifting team used a 250tn mobile crane for loading and discharging.

CEA PROJECTS COMPLETE DIFFICULT TRANSPORTATION IN MYANMAR

CEA Projects Myanmar have completed the transportation and mobilisation of three 9tn drill-rigs and four 20ft containers to Kawlin in the Sagaing region of the country, 850km from the capital, Yangon.

Due to the poor condition of the roads and bridges in the region, the transportation had to be completed in two separate trips over 16 days. Many of the bridges that were crossed had a maximum capacity of just 15tns which meant that on several occasions, the trucks had to be unloaded and then reloaded to adhere to the safe working limit. CEA carried out several route surveys to ensure safe access for both the outward and return journeys. Please see above photos of the cargo.

EUROPE CARGO WITH INCREDIBLE SHIPMENT TO JAPAN

Europe Cargo in Belgium are pleased to share the below set of photos of a current incredible shipment to Japan.

The shipment consisted of 1 produced treatment module (which took 8 months to build at Hollandia Yard), 1 lifting frame, 2 boxes of slings and 8 pallets of shackles at a total weight of 469mtns loaded waterside from the Waalhaven terminal at Rotterdam in the Netherlands and transported to Okpo, Japan.

Anouschka de Haan of the Forwarding Department at Europe Cargo explains: "MV HHL Tokyo" arrived one week before the loading operations were scheduled to begin in order to prepare the cargo hold and positioning of 4 heavy lift platform feet supports which were carefully measured out and welded into position ready for loading.

Once the cargo had arrived, it was welded onto the Hollandia pontoon alongside the vessel. After cutting and grinding operations were completed, the 'Matador 3' floating crane, with a 1,500mtn capacity, hooked the unit (dimensions of 18.6 x 16.7 x 19.1m) which had been properly wrapped in plastic with access to the top lifting points by special inside stairways.

The module was carefully placed into the 4 heavy lift feet supports with vibration pads placed between and cautiously welded onto the vessel's tank-top in the aft part of hold number 2. The lifting frame, which is to be used at the destination, as well as the spare parts, were handled in an indirect way by shore crane and placed in front of the module.

The welding took 4 days after the completion of loading, with intervals of 24 hours in-between for cooling as required for the NDT testing stipulated in the charter contract. The vessel then sailed with an open hold to the destination of Japan with a transit time of around 33 days."

KHIMJI RAMDAS COMPLETE CROSS-BORDER TRANSPORT OF 2 SETS OF CARGO FROM THE UAE TO OMAN

Khimji Ramdas Shipping in Oman have recently completed the cross-border freight management of 2 sets of cargo from the UAE.

The project team at Wilhelmsen Ships Service (WSS) in the UAE have recently handled a shipment in Dubai of 4 passenger ferry boats each weighing 65tns.



Fairplay Shipping in Denmark have completed the return of an important exhibition of China's first Emperor, Qin Shi Huang's Terracotta Warriors to China.



CEA PROJECTS REPORT CHALLENGING TRANSPORT OF POWER PLANT EQUIPMENT IN MYANMAR

CEA Projects Myanmar recently carried out the transportation of 14 gas-powered generator sets and their accompanying parts and accessories from a power plant project in Kyaukpyu (Rakhine State, Western Myanmar) to Yangon and then onwards to Singapore.

The initial part of the project began with the transportation of the vehicles and equipment necessary for the demobilisation. A 1,500tn landing craft tank (LCT) barge was loaded then sailed from Yangon to Kyaukpyu on the West Coast of Myanmar and in preparation for the barge's arrival, a section of beach was cleared with an excavator and steel plates laid down to ensure a smooth and safe roll-off for all the vehicles and equipment. Due to the project involving a beach landing, careful attention was paid to the

local high tides to ensure the barge arrived and departed at the optimum time without any interruption or delay to the operation.

CEA carried out all crane operations at the power plant site and transportation of the 14 generators sets (housed in 20ft containers) to the Posco-Daewoo Jetty 15km away. The containers and accessories were lifted and loaded onto the barge in two separate shifts over 24 hours.



CAPT. SHADI SALAMA OF SHAM LOGISTICS SERVICES INTERVIEWED FOR BREAKBULK MAGAZINE

Capt. Shadi Salama, Partner & Managing Director of Sham Logistics Services, has been interviewed for the latest issue of Breakbulk Magazine regarding out-of-gauge cargo movement in Iraq.

"With an office in Iraq, Kuwait-based Sham Logistics Services is acutely aware of the difficulties of operating in Iraq.

Capt. Shadi Salama, Managing Director and Partner of the company, described the uphill battle Sham faced in moving project cargo to Iraq between 1990 and 2003 when the Kuwait-Iraq borders were closed. All shipments were moved via Kuwait ports and then re-exported to Iraq on a transit basis.

However, the challenges did not lessen once the borders were reopened in 2004. Sham then faced technical problems with height restrictions of five meters on roads and bridges in Kuwait, forcing Sham to flesh out alternative plans for every shipment to avoid obstructions until it reached the Kuwait-Iraq border.

After crossing the border, further challenges included getting clearances from Iraqi Customs officials and moving the cargo on to project sites on poor road conditions that were hampered by a lack of security, Salama said.

Even after Umm Qasr Port restarted operations, there was no relief for project cargo companies as they face continued problems in getting clearances from customs and had to wait long periods before they were able to deliver cargoes to project sites across the country.

Despite the challenges, movements of over-dimensional cargo to Iraq have been very strong since 2004 in tandem with growth in the world economy as the country sought to rebuild. "But the global economic slowdown, coupled with the unstable political situation around the same time, had its effect on the ongoing projects in Iraq and reduced government expenditure has also reduced the import of oversized cargo", Salama said.
