


This delivery is part of an on-going project regarding Alba Pot Line 6

AL NAHRAIN HANDLES PROJECT FOR MINISTRY OF EDUCATION IN IRAQ

Al-Nahrain are pleased to report a recent project they have successfully completed for the Ministry of Education in Iraq involving the handling, clearing and delivery of $162 \times 40'$ (plus $2 \times 20'$) containers of school books in their usual professional way.

The large number of 164 containers were transported from Umm Qasr Port to the Ministry of Education (MOE) warehouse in Baghdad for the books to then be distributed around the country.

Although this was a relatively simple project, time challenges called for a smart solution as Adham Obeidat (Al Nahrain Business Development Manager) explains: "Our main task for this job was basically built on an exempted shipment for a governmental sector. It was agreed with the shipper and consignee that all related documentation and official letters should be ready and in-hand prior to the shipment's arrival at Umm Qasr Port. However, some of the documents were incomplete and required amendments that effected the release of the shipment as planned. So, Al Nahrain intervened and managed to minimise the delay as much as possible by assisting in completing the documentation and through our influence with the related departments. Amendments in similar cases have meant delays of up to 2 months, but we managed to swiftly clear the shipment.

Our interference in accelerating the amendments was fruitful and eventually we completed customs clearance formalities and the 1st lot of our trucks departed the same day to the MOE warehouse in Baghdad. To avoid any truck shortages for the loading process, the complete quantity of 163 trucks were ready and entered the port spontaneously as per our schedule and the port loading capacity. Customs clearance was processed on a parallel level and we applied the maximum level for the loading ratio and managed to complete the loading of 163 trucks within 48 hours with all operations completed smoothly and safely."

All containers were delivered in Baghdad safe and sound and without delay. As usual, Al Nahrain directed major importance to the project and dealt with this shipment with full efficiency and high professionalism despite the time challenges and prompt solutions required to release the shipment. Adham concludes: "We are proud to be part of this project and glad about the feedback that we received from our client as well as the consignee, both fully satisfied with our performance".

PCN JOINS FIGHT TO BATTLE PLASTIC POLLUTION AT THEIR 8TH ANNUAL SUMMIT

Project Cargo Network (PCN) recently held what they believe to be the greenest meeting in the industry's history. Firstly, thousands of air travel miles were saved by holding their network meeting in one place so that their Members don't have to make countless individual trips to visit their fellow partners who are situated all over the world

Secondly, most similar events use 100s of single use plastic water bottles over their duration, which can take between 400 and 1.000 years to decompose.



From harming marine life to littering beaches and congesting landfills, the disturbing growth of plastics is threatening our world.

To help battle plastic pollution, PCN provided their delegates with BPA free reusable aluminium bottles and the hotel supplied pitchers of water in the conference room.

Mr Ivo Antonio Mafra, President of DC Logistics in Brazil said: "The reusable bottles are a great idea, very easy to use in the meeting room. I will take mine back with me - it keeps the water fresh and cold, a well-made product."

PCN also gave their delegates reusable, recyclable Conference Bags saving the standard plastic bags used to carry company brochures from sitting in a landfill. It takes less energy to create nonwoven polypropylene bags than is used to create cotton bags and they were also very popular

The summit was held at the Real InterContinental in San José who constantly monitor their diesel boilers so that most of the time the biomass boiler (alternative energy) is used, thus minimising fossil fuel consumption and helping to reduce their carbon footprint. Earlier in 2018, Costa Rica's President Carlos Alvarado announced plans to ban fossil fuels and to become the first fully decarbonised country in the world.

PCN President/C.E.O. Rachel Humphrey said "As many PCN Members are working in the renewable energy field, and the PCN Head Office holds an ISO 14001 Environmental Management certificate – this was an apt and inspiring country to host our meeting. We welcomed C.E.O.s and Senior Managers from more than 60 countries to our gathering in Costa Rica, and if we have helped promote a greener attitude, then that is fantastic!"

ATLAS WITH EXECUTION OF TWO MAJOR PROJECTS

In November 2018, ATLAS exported a salt melting furnace and its accessories from Shuaiba Port in Kuwait to Valencia, Spain for their client Herlogas

The job had to be completed within a week due to the impending expiry of the temporary bond obtained from the Kuwait customs.

ATLAS' scope of work was to move the complete cargo (dimensions of 5.3 > 4.4 x 4.1 m and weight of 27 MT) and equipment by sea

Since this was an ODC, ATLAS had to arrange their own equipment to cross load the container

The furnace was of sensitive material and ATLAS couldn't directly expose it to metal chains, so they hired a third-party to make cushions for them which were used before lashing the cargo in during transit from Dubai.

Project #2 - December, 2018

In December 2018, ATLAS exported prefabricated building structures and glass wool insulation materials for multiple clients, including Kimmco-Isove and Kirby Building Systems.


The first set of dimensions for ATLAS' first export were standard trucks (12 meter side walled) and standard dry containers with cargo weighing between 12 to 24 tons. For their second client it was standard trucks (12 meter side walled) and standard dry containers with cargo weight ranging between 4 to 12 tons.

The mode of transportation used was a combination of sea and land. By road the origin was Kuwait and the destination was GCC & Levant Areas. By sea, origin remained the same but the destination was Qatar, Yemen, Africa, Cyprus & Pakistan etc.

All the problems and delays were handled by ATLAS by pre-planning container bookings with various shipping lines as per the destination requirement of client.

ATLAS coordinated with the transportation department to have the required number of trucks on standby. ATLAS also had round-the-clock operations coordination with the loading team at the factory to make sure export customs documents were issued accurately.
