

CROWN LOGISTICS DELIVER BULK SHIPMENT TO LAOS

In September, Crown Logistics (members in Vietnam) successfully managed the transit customs clearance and transportation of fuel silo parts and their accessories. The bulk cargo was shipped from Shanghai in China to Hai Phong Port in Vietnam with the final destination in the Xepon District in Savannakhet, Laos.

The cargo travelled a distance of 798km from Hai Phong Port to the factory site in Laos using low-bed chassis trucks with the total volume of the shipment measured at nearly 500cbm.

Peter Linh (Managing Director) explains: "We had a good period of consultancy with our client to understand the difficulties of the transportation schedule from Hai Phong Port to Laos through the inland Lao Bao / Savannakhet borders. It took 2 nights of transportation to reach the border and arrange transit customs before the trucks could pass through into Laos."

"During the transportation, we ran into problems with heavy rain and wind which impeded operations. However, our drivers are well-experienced in moving cargo to Laos and even though some areas were flooded along the way with dangerous winds and deep water on the road which strongly affected our delivery and unloading plans, our professional operations team smoothly and safely solved the problems."

Crown Logistics finally delivered the cargo to the open yard site smoothly and successfully and within 3 days with safety as the highest priority and zero issues.



NEW WORLD LOGISTICS WITH AIR TRANSPORT OF ROTOR SHAFT



First Global Logistics have handled a recent shipment of 5 subsea production structures from Suez in Egypt to an offshore site in Mumbai, India.

Sabry (Business Development Manager) explains: "Back in 2017, First Global Logistics was awarded the 1st job movement for one of our precious clients of 6 offshore metal structures serving an oil field. We successfully and safely moved the 6 steel units from the client's plant in Suez to Mumbai. In September 2019, we received a notice from the same client that we have been automatically awarded as their first choice for moving a new set of a similar subsea structures from the same plant in Suez to same destination in Mumbai."

Mazen continues: "Despite the huge dimensions of the cargo and the road obstacles that we had to face, we used our experience from the previous project to smoothly transport the units by conducting a thorough road survey with RBA (Road & Bridges Authority) approval, arranging a police escort convoy and doing some civil works by removing the port of loading's (Adabiya Port) main gate. The previous job took 3 weeks of work but due to our understanding of the project, this one took only 3 days of work plus 1 day of execution."

The scope of work handled by First Global Logistics included:

- Loading of the 5 subsea units at the shipper's plant using a 100th capacity crane
- Lashing & securing of the units on 2 extendable lowbed trailers
- Trucking from the plant in Suez to Adabiya Port
- Arranging the police escort convoy
- Road & Bridges Authority approvals;
- Civil work and the removal of Adabiya Port's main gate
- Hooking on of cargo using vessel cranes

Managing Director at O&S, Kurt Camilleri explains: "The entire operation had to be planned in one week and in this case, the yacht couldn't sail on its own power at all so after considering several options, we used the services of the impressive yacht-carrying vessel, the Super Servant 4, a semi-submersible vessel dedicated to yacht relocation around the world."

After careful planning, the yacht was loaded and secured into position on the Super Servant 4 and was ready for transportation. Kurt: "The mission was further complicated by strong winds and usually a yacht-transfer of this size would be carried out at an assigned anchorage area, however the wind did not permit such an operation. Due to these circumstances, we had to convince the authorities to allow the operation within Valletta

Port with a thorough risk assessment. Another issue was the sea depth in the port and we had to ensure we picked a deeper spot within the port for the operations."
