

BATI Shipping & Trading in Turkey are continuing to deliver more yachts as the weather gets warmer and people cannot wait to get on their boats!





some inconvenience, this is a Force Majeure situation and we want to provide Members with a clear and safe way forward in what is a challenging time.



Origin Logistics have recently shipped metal sharers from the factory in Turkey to both Melbourne in Australia and India.

All processes, including door-to-door service transportation, lashing and securing was smoothly managed by the Origin Logistics team. Additionally, fumigation had to be applied in tents prior to the departure due to custom regulations in Australia as photographed above.

The shipment to Australia (406cbm / 145tns) was loaded onto flat-rack and open-top containers at the factory and will be trans-loaded to low-bed trucks at Melbourne Port for delivery to the final destination. The shipment to India had a total cargo volume of 320cbm and 110tn weight.

Green Channel Forwarders in India are pleased to report their latest shipment of a machine (falcon mobile metal recovery plant), a conveyor and spare parts. The machine weighed 48mt and measured 12.5 x 2.9 x 3.9m.

Tushar Murlidharan from Green Channel explains: "We are proud to announce that we got the opportunity to handle yet another shipment for our customer, Harsco India Pvt Ltd. This was a very complex machine and needed high levels of expertise to handle. As it was a self-propelled and remote-operated machine, it required a mobile generator to give electric support to start and roll out the machine from the RORO vessel which we arranged while discharging the cargo from the vessel.

The machine didn't have the supports to lift by crane and therefore, we had to fabricate a steel ramp weighing 3.5mt for loading the machine with the remote control and DG support which you can see in the photographs above. There were also number of permissions and formalities involved and we successfully completed the task."




The latest project from BATI Group has involved flat-racks from Turkey to Oman.
